

Cookies Policy

1. Type of cookies used by the website

The website uses exclusively technical cookies for its work; in particular the cookies used are the following:

- opendyslexic which can be set to the value yes to indicate the website to adjust the font to the OpenDyslexic¹ font which can be helpful for people with reading difficulties;
- cookies which can be set to the value yes to indicate the website to hide the cookies policy banner;

Both these cookies are deleted one day after their creation.

The website doesn't use any other cookie for its work; in particular there aren't social media or any form of tracking cookies.

Even the font OpenDyslexic and the pictures displayed on the website are saved locally on the website server and don't require the connection to other websites.

The website doesn't use marketing or profiling cookies either.

2. Way the user is informed of the cookies usage

When the user connects to the website he/she is required to accept the cookie policy; by continuing surfing the website the user will be considered as aware of the cookies and their usage as described in this policy.

The user is also aware of the installation of the cookies when they are created by a popup; if the *Cancel* option is pressed the cookie won't be created.

3. Way the user can delete the cookies

The user can delete all the cookies used in the website by using his/her browser functionality², by pressing the *Delete all cookies* button in the informative banner or by using the *deleteAllCookies*: *deleteAllCookies()* in the browser JavaScript console.
