All the procedures described are reserved for the project partners which are the only ones can be registered on the website and login by using the apposite page *Partners login*.

1. Collected data and treatment aim

The data collected by the website consists of:

- surname, name;
- email address;
- nationality.

The collected data is only used to offer the service; in particular the information will only be visible by the website developer in order to give you assistance while needed.

Your data won't be published anywhere else if you don't do so; for example you can insert your name in articles so as to indicate you're the author. In this case or others similar to this you're doing so on your responsibility and both the website developer and project partners will be responsible for these pieces of data.

According to the actual normative nobody under the age of 16 can be registered the website. By asking to be registered (accepting this policy) you're implicitly confirming you're aware of this and you're 16 years old or older.

Once the users (referring to a project partner) is registered to the website he/she can publish articles or/and documents on the website; it's anyway faculty of the developer to remove partially or completely what's been published if the project manager decides so (for example for issues such as plagiarism or if some contents are considered out of context, confidential, offensive, ...).

2. Data collection and conservation

The data are collected from the contacts the partner gave to the project manager or partners; when he/she decides to be registered on the website he's implicitly accepting this policy in every part.

The database is collocated in Italy (European Union) and fully respects the users' privacy; it's only accessible from the developer in case of maintenance or in order to provide assistance. The passwords are saved in an encrypted form (hash) and can't be read or used by anyone. In case of security problems all the data stored in the database will be deleted as a security precaution.

3. Unsubscribe from the website

It's possible for the users to unsubscribe from the website by pressing the *Unsubscribe* link in the personal area. It will involve:

- the permanent elimination of the data specified at the point 1;
- the impossibility to publish anything else.

In case of difficulties it's possible to require assistance on this matter by sending an email to info@fin-literacy.eu describing the problem.

4. User's rights

The user can ask for, according to the EU normative n. 2016/679:

- a check of the existence of his personal data on the website (art. 15);
- the rectification or the remotion of his data on the website (art. 16-17);
- limit his data to be used for conservation aims only (art. 18);
- the data portability, meaning receiving them from one of the data responsables, in a structured format, of common use and readable from an automatic device, and transmitting them to another one without any sort of difficulty (art. 20).

5. Newer versions of this document

If a newer version of the privacy policy is published all the registered users will receive a communication within 15 days from the publication and will be able to unsubscribe from the website.

If the user doesn't proceed within the specified term of 15 days he will be considered aware of the new privacy policy and (implicitly) agreeing with it.
